



AFP GREATER TORONTO CHAPTER PHILANTHROPY AWARDS OUTSTANDING VOLUNTEER FUNDRAISER

Purpose

The AFP Greater Toronto Chapter has established this award to be presented to an individual, couple or family in recognition of their exceptional skills in managing and motivating groups of donors and volunteers for fundraising projects for the benefit of nonprofit organizations and a commitment to the advancement of philanthropy.

Eligibility & Nomination Criteria

An individual member of AFP Greater Toronto Chapter or the Awards Selection Committee or the AFP Greater Toronto Chapter Board may submit a nomination for this award.

The nomination should include the following information with specific examples from the nominators' organization:

- Evidence of quality leadership and organizational ability in fundraising campaigns and description of success of fundraising efforts.
- Details about the background/commitment of the candidate in advancing inclusion, and reflecting the diversity of our community.
- Description of time, effort and personal financial commitment.
- Evidence of success in recruiting and motivating others.
- Description of participation in other local, national and/or international non-profit organizations.

****The recipient cannot be employed professionally in the not-for-profit sector.****

Submission Criteria

Each nomination should include the nomination form, the narrative and any supporting documents. The narrative should be no longer than 3 pages (12-point format with 1" margins). *Supporting documents are accepted, but only to support the narrative.* No more than 6 pages of supporting documents are allowed. No new information to be introduced in the supporting documents.

The Awards Selection Committee, chaired by the Past President of AFP Greater Toronto Chapter, will be asked to review candidates based on the eligibility criteria set out above. If in the judgment of the Committee, no applicants meet the criteria, no award will be given in this category.
