



## AFP GREATER TORONTO CHAPTER PHILANTHROPY AWARDS OUTSTANDING YOUTH IN PHILANTHROPY

### **Purpose**

The AFP Greater Toronto Chapter has established a Youth in Philanthropy Award to be presented in recognition of outstanding volunteerism and leadership by youth. One of the Chapter's central roles is to broaden the public's awareness of the value of philanthropy. Additionally, the Chapter feels a responsibility to foster coming generations of volunteers, donors and professionals in the charitable sector. By establishing this award the chapter hopes to serve both aims, while giving richly deserved recognition to the efforts of youth, **5 to 23 years of age** who are involved in philanthropic activities.

### **Eligibility & Nomination Criteria**

An individual member of AFP Greater Toronto Chapter or the Awards Selection Committee or the AFP Greater Toronto Chapter Board may submit a nomination for this award.

### **List the nominee's achievements, including:**

- Description of what the nominee did and the results that were achieved. (Can include goals, process, budget (if relevant) and other people involved in the process (adult leaders or advisers).
- Details about the background/commitment of the candidate in advancing inclusion, and reflecting the diversity of our community.
- Description of the impact the nominee had on the community, including numbers of people involved, financial impact, organizations helped, etc. **Please include the names and contact information of individuals at the organizations who benefited from the nominee's work.**
- Outline the potential for the long term (1-5 years) impact of the nominee's work. Will the project(s) be ongoing and has the nominee considered next steps or is working on other projects? Can the project be easily replicated and if so, how?

### **Submission Criteria**

Each nomination should include the nomination form, the narrative and any supporting documents. The narrative should be no longer than 3 pages (12-point format with 1" margins). *Supporting documents (no more than six (6) pages) are accepted, but only to support the narrative.* No new information to be introduced in the supporting documents.

The Awards Selection Committee, chaired by the Past President of AFP Greater Toronto Chapter, will be asked to review candidates based on the eligibility criteria set out above. If in the judgment of the Committee, no applicants meet the criteria, no award will be given in this category.
