Each day, our team ensures that the essential supports offered by Fred Victor are available for those experiencing instability, illustrates the power of creating space for clients to make change in their lives, and facilitates our city moving towards an end to homelessness.

What You Will Do:

- Establish relationships with and execute annual giving cycle for 250-500 individual donors at the \$1000-\$2,500 annual gift level, and manage a pool of community organizations, faith groups, and foundation donors, giving under \$10,000 annually, including cultivation, solicitation and stewardship.
- Develop and execute annual strategy for donor engagement to meet revenue goals.
- Identify, cultivate, and solicit mid-level prospects from a variety of sources, and identify major donor prospects from existing donor pool

- Conduct research and prepare donor profiles
- Prepare solicitation letters, grant applications, proposals and impact reports and thank you letters as required
- Maintain donor records, including communications, personal information, relationship networking, and pipeline status
